As we run with perseverance the race



Twenty years ago a quiet, cynical, nihilistic, brooding teenager was invited by a friend to church.

There I learnt acceptance, curiosity, flexibility, and surrender — all in a tonne of contexts to exercise skills and responsibilities, surrounded by generous, loving, down-to-earth people. 
